The following rules and procedures have been established by the Southern Kentucky Performing Arts Gingerbread Contest Committee. Please retain this information for your records. - *All entries must be registered by Friday, November 2, 2018 at 5:00pm CST. (An email confirmation and entry number will be assigned.)
- *Entries will be limited to delivery on Sunday, November 11th, between 1:00pm - 5:00pm CST.

All Gingerbread Homes are to be on exhibit in the SKyPAC Lobby until Saturday, November 17th to qualify for the People's Choice Awards. Gingerbread Houses are to be picked up Sunday, November 18th, 1:00pm-3:00pm CST. Award Winning entries will remain on display in the Main Gallery to be picked up Monday, December 17 during SKyPAC business hours.

ENTRY CATEGORIES:

- There are six entry categories:
 - **Professional Category:** Open to anyone who currently or previously has received payment for their cake/pastry skills or is a trained professional. Professional category is also open to artists and non-bakers.
 - **Amateur Category:** Open to school groups, churches, organizations, businesses, individuals, families, or groups of friends.
 - **Youth Grades PreK-5:** Open to individuals or teams. Adults may only supervise and cannot contribute to building or designing the gingerbread house.
 - **Youth Grades 6-8:** Open to individuals or teams. Adults may only supervise and cannot contribute to building or designing the gingerbread house.
 - **Youth Grades 9-12:** Open to individuals or teams. Adults may only supervise and cannot contribute to building or designing the gingerbread house.

Guidelines

- * Entries must be originals and **cannot** be made from a kit.
- * Entries must be on a covered, sturdy square, or rectangle base.
- * Maximum size of base cannot exceed 24" x 24" total. There are no height restrictions.
- * Structure must primarily be made out of Gingerbread.
- * Premade gingerbread is acceptable. (Houses built from kits are ineligible for awards.)
- * All visible parts must be edible, with the exception of the base and battery-operated lighting.
- * The theme is "Holiday/Winter" – Use your creativity! All designs welcome!
- * Entries will be viewed from all directions on 6 ft. tables.
- * Candies must be unwrapped.

The Gingerbread Homes for the Arts Contest Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate.

Judging and Awards

- *Judging will take place on Monday, November 12, 2018.
- *1st, 2nd and 3rd Place Winners will be chosen in each of the six categories.
- *An overall GRAND CHAMPION will be chosen by the Judges.
- *A "People's Choice Award" will be determined by the most votes during the week-long Festival. Each vote is \$1.00 per ticket.
- *A "Kid's Choice Award" will be chosen by the students during the school day performance.
- *Ginger Sweet Honors (the number of these awards is at the discretion of the judges with a minimum of one of each):

Most Whimsical	Most Creative	Best Original Concept
Best Use of Color	Most Delicious Looking	Most Festive
- Celebrate Bowling Green (entries must have a holiday/winter theme and honor the uniqueness of the Bowling Green/Warren County community, such as area landmarks, special traditions, local heroes, etc.)

We are encouraging all entrants to donate their creations for the online auction. The auction begins Monday, November 12th at 5:00pm CST through Saturday, November 17th at 5:00pm. The auction winner can pick up their entry Sunday, November 18th, 1:00pm-3:00pm CST. The auction winner can also choose to donate the entry to the nonprofit of the entrant's choice. The Gingerbread Contest Committee will deliver donated entries to nonprofits in Bowling Green. Entrants choosing a nonprofit outside Bowling Green will deliver the entry. All auction proceeds benefit SKyPAC's work in Arts Education and Arts Programming.
